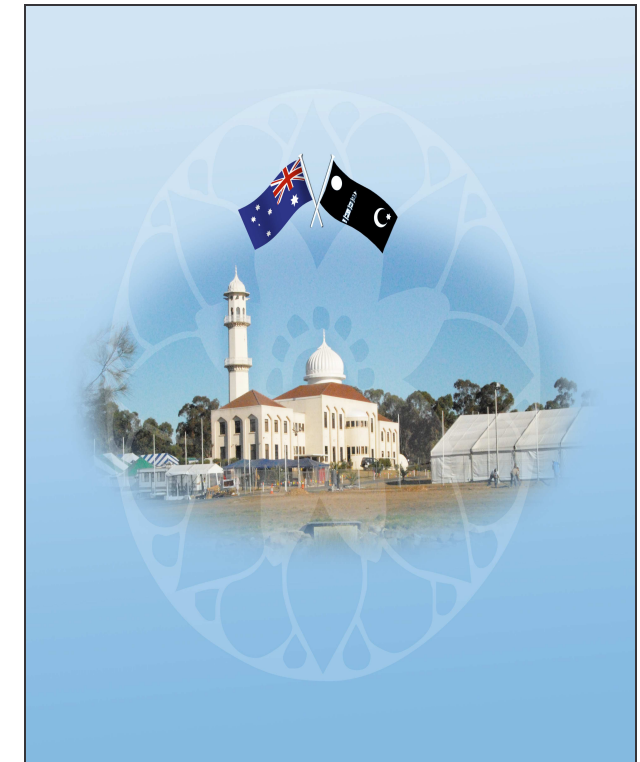

Insha'Allah, Jalsa Salana Australia will be held this year on April 6, 7 and 8, 2006 at Masjid Bait-ul-Huda, Sydney.

This brochure contains important information about this Jalsa Salana that all members should know. We expect that all members will follow the instructions provided in this brochure and fully cooperate with organizers and volunteers to avoid any unpleasant incident.

1. Registration.

Computerised registration cards will be issued to all guests. These cards will be available for collection through the respective presidents on arrival in Sydney.

IMPORTANT: Entry is restricted to members/guests by scanning of registration cards only, for security reasons. Please have your registration cards ready for scanning as you come into the mosque for Jalsa. It is also advised that if you leave during the Jalsa proceedings for any reason, remember to take your card with you as you may be asked to produce the card for scanning on your return. Members and guests are also advised to have their registration cards displayed at all times so that they can be easily identified and the security staff can ensure that there are no unauthorized visitors. If any members or guests lose their registration cards, they should report the lost card immediately to registration staff to avoid any misuse of lost card and to obtain a new card.

2. Transport

As always, transport will be provided for pick-ups and drop-offs for members travelling by buses, trains and air at the designated pick-up points. Members travelling by air are advised to catch trains to Central station, which run from both domestic and international terminals and change at Central for Blacktown or Rooty Hill stations which are our designated pick-up locations.

However, special arrangements could be made, outside working hours, for airport pick-ups only for elderly and sick

by contacting Nazim Transport in advance. Taxi is also a good option for members travelling in groups of up to 5, which should cost around \$ 20 per head

3. Accommodation

Accommodation will be available to interstate guests at local members' residences, as per our tradition. However, accommodation for Khuddam and single guests will be arranged at Masjid Bait-ul-Huda.

During Easter time, it is very difficult to get accommodation in Sydney, as there are a number of events taking place including Royal Easter Show, Dog show and a few different sporting events. A lot of the Hotels have already been booked out by people and organizations taking part in these events. It is recommended that members planning to get private accommodation should do so at their earliest possible to avoid disappointment.

A list of Hotels/Motels/Caravan Parks in the area adjacent to Masjid Bait-ul-Huda with rates and availability has been forwarded to Presidents of all Jamaats. This list is also available at Jamaat's website www.ahmadiyya.org.au.

Jamaat has also arranged special group rates with one of the Caravan Parks less than 15 minutes away from the mosque. Please contact your respective presidents as soon as possible if you wish to secure accommodation in this facility.

4. Information, Lost & Found

Separate Information, Lost & Found desks for Lajna and men will be located near their respective entrances. All important information regarding this Jalsa Salana and other relevant information will be available from information desks.

All items found lost/unattended should be deposited at the information desks. It is recommended that members do not carry large sums of cash and other un-necessary valuable items to avoid the risk of losing them.

5. Medical Facilities

Medical teams have been appointed to provide first aid and emergency medical assistance only on both Lajna and men side. Information about on duty medical staff and nearest Hospital/Medical center will be available from information desks and will also be displayed on notice boards on both sides of the Mosque. Travelling members are requested to bring their Medicare/Health care cards with them.

Homeopathic medicine will also be available at gents Information/Medical desk.

6. Bookstall / Exhibition

Main bookstall and exhibition will be located near reception between ladies and gents entrance. Bookstall will be open for all members to visit and purchase books during breaks of Jalsa Salana and will close at 8:30 pm every night. There will be a smaller display of books on Lajna side, however, Lajna are free to visit main bookstall and exhibition at any time. Library will be closed during the days of Jalsa Salana.

Guests are encouraged to visit bookstall & exhibition as there will be a large number of new books available on display as well as for sale.
