A-1: The name Ahmadiyyat is the name of a reinterpretation or restatement of the religion of The Holy Quran which is Islam

A-2: Ahmadis believe that Allah exists, Allah is One, Allah is Holy, Allah listen the prayers of his servants and Allah speaks to his chosen servants and reveals to them his purpose

Q-3: What are the main differences between Ahmadis and other Muslims?

A-3: Ahmadis believe that Jesus died a natural death where as non Ahmadis believe that Jesus was ascended to heaven and is sitting on the fourth sky

A-4: Ahmadis believe that the second coming of Messiah means coming of a follower of a Holy Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) where as Non Ahmadis believe that the second coming of messiah means that Jesus will come for a second time.

Q-5: What is the meaning of Khatam-al-nabuvvat?

A-5: The correct meaning of Khatam-al-nabuvvat is seal of Nabuvvat or attestation of Nabuvvat which means that Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) is the seal of Prophets

Q-6: Does Ahmadis believe in Jihad

A-6: YES

Q-7: What type of Jihad does the Ahmadis Believe?

A-7: Ahmadis believe in the Jihad with the help of Quranic knowledge, Jihad with the help of pen rather than the Jihad with the help of sword

Q-8: What did Hazrath Mirza Gulam Ahmad Qadiani AS claimed for the people of different religions

A-8: Hazrath Mirza Gulam Ahmad Qadiani AS claimed that he is a promised mehdi for Muslims, messiah for Christians, the masiodarbahmi for Zoroastrians and Krishna for Hindus

Q-10: When and where was International Islamic Religious conference held and who presided it?

A-10: The International Islamic Religious conference was held in 1993 in Medina and King Faisal presided it

Q-11: What did King Faisal said the International Islamic Religious conference about Jihad

A-11: O respected brothers; you have all been called to raise the standard of Jihad in the way of God. Jihad is not only the carrying the rifles or waving of a sword; but Jihad is inviting people towards the book of God and the tradition of chosen messenger to act upon them.

Q-12: In which book did Promised messiah addressed the Queen Victoria

A-12: Promised Messiah addressed the queen in the book “ Aina Kamalat-e-Islam”

Q-13: What message did Promised Messiah gave to Queen Victoria in his book

A-13: “O” Honorable queen, I am surprised that you deny the religion of Islam, despite your knowledge and insight

Q-14: A well known Pakistani historian Sheikh Mohammad Akram wrote about Ahmadis. What did he said about Ahmadis

A-14: Of the Muslims of the world, it was the Ahmadis who understood the reality that although it was the time of political decline for Muslims, the Muslims could avail of the opportunity- that was new in the history of religion

Q-15: What is the position of Islamic teachings in respect of women

A-15: Islam has assigned a position of dignity and honor to women which is essential for peace, comfort, happiness and continuation of species

Q-16: What is the ultimate purpose of marriage in Islam

A-16: To win the pleasure of Allah through chastity

Q-17: What did Holy Prophet (pbuh) said about marriage

A-17: Marriage and conjugal life is our way, he who turns aside from our way is not from us

Q-18: What is the Holy Prophet’s (pbuh) direction upon starting a conjugal relationship

A-18: Holy Prophet (pbuh) directed Muslims to supplicate “O’ Allah safeguard us against Satan and keep Satan away from us

Q-19: What does Holy Quran describes about spouses

A-19: Holy Quran describes husband and wife as garments to each other, where garments covers you up the main responsibility of the spouses is to coven each other which also means security and dignity

Q-20: Why men are appointed as guardian over their family

A-20: Men are appointed guardian over women because of the fact that Allah had made some of them excel others in some areas while excel in other areas. Men spend their wealth and women spend their time towards their family

Q-21: If a wife is disobedient, what are the instructions for men

A-21: If a wife is disobedient towards men Islam has given the following instructions to men Firstly men should admonish them, then temporarily withdraw them from marital bed, in the last resort he may have to recourse to light chastisement

Q-22: What did the Holy Prophet (pbuh) said about a divorce

A-22: Of that which is permitted in Islam the most obnoxious in the estimation of Allah is a divorce

Q-23: What is Polygamy

A-23: Having more than one wife is called as Polygamy

Q-24: Is Polygamy acceptable in Islam

A-24: Yes Polygamy is an acceptable act in Islam

Q-25: Why is Polygamy an acceptable act in Islam

A-25: Polygamy is an acceptable act in Islam with which the chastity of men and women are safeguarded

Q-26: How many wives are permitted in Islam at a given time

A-26: Up to Four wives are permitted

Q-27: What are the conditions of Polygamy

A-27: If a person wants to have more than one wife there are some conditions attached to it. They are: One has to treat justly between the wives in the means of keeping equality in the matter of maintenance, provisions and companionship

Q-28: When was the married women's property ACT passed in British Parliament

A-28: The married women's property ACT was passed in the British Parliament only in the year 1882

Q-29: What was the economic position of women in Britain before the "Married women property Act"

A-29: No women can hold a property on her own name. Even if she gets a property from her father, upon marriage the property goes to her husband's name

Q-30: When a person dies and leaves behind property and children what is the share of male children and female children

A-30: If a person dies leaving property, Islam has fixed the rates of distribution according to the needs of the people. Male children get two parts and female children get one part

Q-31: What is the right of a wife against her husband according to the Holy Prophet (pbuh)

A-31: The Holy Prophet has said that the wife has equal rights. He said that feed her when you feed yourself, clothe her when you clothe yourself, do not strike her, do not relieve her and do not separate her from yourself

Q-32: What did the Holy prophet say to the believers

A-32: The Holy Prophet said to his believers, the most perfect of the believers in the matter of faith is he whose behavior is best, and the best of you are those who behave best towards their wives (Tirmidhi)

Q-33: What did the Holy Prophet say regarding the rights of Orphans and Women

A-33: The Holy Prophet said that Allah has declared sinful to one who fails to safeguard the rights of two weak ones "The Orphans" and "The Women"

Q-34: What did Umm Salamah relate regarding the act of women

A-34: Umm Salamah relates that The Holy Prophet said 'that if a woman dies and her husband is pleased with her, she will enter the paradise

Q-35: Treat women kindly. Women have been created from a crooked rib. If you try to straighten it, it will break and if you leave it alone it will remain crooked. Who related this Hadith and in which book.

A-35: Abu Hurairah related this Hadith in the book Bokhari and Muslim

Q-36: Let no Muslim man entertain any rancour against Muslim women. Should he dislike one quality in her he would find another which is pleasing. Who related this Hadith and in which book

A-36: Abu Hurairah in Muslim

Q-37: When a husband calls his wife to his bed and the wife refuses and he spends the night offended with her. The angels keep cursing her through the night. Who narrated this Hadith and in which book

A-37: Abu Hurairah in Bokhari

Q-38: Had I ordained that a person should prostrate before another, I would have commended that a wife should prostrate herself before her husband who narrated this Hadith and where

A-38: Abu Hurairah in Tirmidhi

Q-39: Of the money you spend in the way of Allah, you spend for the freedom of a slave, you give away to poor, and you spend on your wife and children which is the most respect of reward

A-39: The money which has been spent on your wife and children has the most respected reward in the eyes of Allah

Q-40: Whatever you might spend seeking pleasure of Allah will have a reward, even that which you put in the mouth of your wife. Who narrated this Hadith and where

A-40: Sa Ibn Abi Waqvas in Bokhari & Muslim

Q-41: What is the meaning of :Zawj”

A-41: Zawj in Quran is related to a pair or a mate and its usage refers to marriage

Q-42: What are the conditions of a marriage for its validity

A-42: There are four basic conditions of marriage without which a marriage is null and void

1. Consent of both parties
2. Mahr
3. Witness of two adult males
4. Publicly announces

Q-43: What importance did Holy prophet (pbuh) gave to marriage and who narrated this Hadith

A-43: Holy Prophet said when a man marries he has fulfilled half of his religious obligations. Hazrath Anas narrated this Hadith

Q-44: What should be the criteria for a person to select a partner for marriage

A-44: Taqwa (Piety) should be the most powerful criteria when selecting a partner for marriage

Q-45: What is Mahr (Dower)

A-45: This is a wife's entitlement to a marriage gift that will be her own.

Q-46: When should the Mahr (Dower) be paid to the wife

A-46: Mahr or Dower may be prompt or deferred depending on the agreement between the parties

Q-47: What should be the type of Mahr (Dower)

A-47: Mahr or Dower can be in the form of Money, Gold, Property, or any nonmaterial like teaching Quran

Q-48: What did the Holy prophet stressed in his last Sermon

A-48: The Holy Prophet stressed on the Kindness on Women in his last Sermon of his life

Q-49: What are the duties of a wife

A-49: The duties of a wife include to contribute for the success and blissfulness of the marriage, must be attentive to the comfort and well-being of her husband

Q-50: What should a man ask from Allah for his family

A-50: A man should seek blessings from Allah in this way “O Allah grant us wives and offspring who will be the apples of our eyes and guide us to be models for the righteous

Q-51: What are the characters of a good wife

A-51: A good wife must be faithful, honest, trustworthy, and she must not entertain any strangers in the house without the knowledge and consent of her husband

Q-52: How many Surahs are there in the Holy Quran

A-52: 114

Q-53: How many time was Bismillah Hirrahman Nirrahim repeated in the Holy Quran

A-53: 113

Q-54: Which Surah mentions 27 attributes of Allah

A-54: Surah AlHadid

Q-55: Which is the longest chapter of the Holy Quran and which is the longest verse

A-55: Longest Chapter in Al Baqrah and the longest verse is Verse 282 of Al Baqrah

Q-56: Who is the author of the book “Dawatul Ameer” and who translated it in English and what is the name in English

A-56: Hazrath Mirza Bashir Uddin Mahmood Ahmad Khalifatul Messiah 2nd wrote the book Dawatul Ameer and this book is translated in English by Mirza Mubarak Ahmad Sb. The English name is “ Invitation to Ahmadiyyat”

Q-57: What did Hazrath Abu Bakr said at the sad demise of the Holy Prophet

A-57: At the demise of Holy Prophet Hazrath Abu Baks said “ the Holy Prophet is but a prophet. There have been prophets before him and they have all died. If he also should die or be put to death. Would you turn back upon him”

Q-58: What did Allah said regarding the protection of the Holy Quran

A-58: Allah says Verily “ we our self have sent down this exhortation and most surely we will be its guardian

Q-59: What does the protection of Holy Quran means

A-59: The protection of Holy Quran means the protection of Islam

Q-60: What astronomical events took place to evidence the advent of Mehdi AS

A-60: The main astronomical event which took place to evidence the advent of Imam Mehdi is the Solar and Lunar eclipse in the month of Ramadan

Q-61: What state of morals did Holy Prophet predicted as a sign of time when Promised Messiah will come

A-61: The Holy prophet (pbuh) predicted that there will be increase in sexual immorality, and people will take pride in being sexual immoral, increased gambling, adultery, increased alcoholic drinks, regards to parents will decline

Q-62: What social conditions did the Holy Prophet predicted as the sign when promised messiah will come

A-62: The Holy Prophet said when the people will be respected by their financial status, believers will be degraded, good men will become obscure, and women will be less dressed, pretty women will be employed in shops to promote the business, men will try to look like women.

This is the time when the messiah will come

Q-63: What did the Holy Prophet predicted about sex ratio

A-63: The Holy Prophet said that the women will outnumber the men when Messiah will come

Q-64: What Did the Holy Prophet predicted about the Transport

A-64: The Holy Prophet predicted that the traditional transport which is camel will disappear and the new no life transports will be invented

Q-65: What did Hazrath Omar asked Holy Prophet about Dajjal and what was Prophet's reply

A-65: Hazrath Omar asked permission from the Holy Prophet to strike Dajjal and behead him with his sword

Holy Prophet replied that it is not for you but for the Messiah to Kill Dajjal

Q-66: Who are the first four People who believed Islam

A-66: 1. Hazrath Abu Bakr 2. Hazrath Khadija, 3. Hazrath Ali, 4. Hazrath Zaid Bin Haris

Q-67: What did Maulvi Muhammad Ali wrote about the book Brahin-e-Ahmadiyya written by Promised Messiah

A-67: Maulvi Muhammad Ali who later became enemy of Promised Messiah wrote that this book has without a parallel in our time and in view of the circumstances and need of our time. There has not been another book like this in the history of Islam

Q-68: Who issued the first Fatwa of Kufr against Promised Messiah

A-68: Maulvi Muhammad Hussain Batalwi

Q-69: Where and how did Jesus died and where is his grave

A-69: Jesus died a natural death in a suburb called Khanyar in Sreenagar, Kashmir, India

Q-70: Where did Jesus traveled after being saved from the cross

A-70: Jesus traveled towards the East, going to Iran, Afganistan and India after being saved from the cross and later died in Kashmir

Q-71: What was the religion of Bawa Guru Nanak

A-71: Bawa guru Nanak was a Muslim

Q-72: Who was the first Moosi outside the Indian Subcontinent

A-72: Hazrath Sufi Hassan Moosa Khan Sb who came to Australia as a camel driver

Q-73: What did Huzoor aba hoped from the Ahmadi of Australia

A-74: Huzoor aba hoped that in the light of Hazrath Sufi Hassan Moosa Khan sahib's wasiyyat each Ahmadi may become Moosi

Q-74: At the end of his Friday sermon on 14th April 2006 what did Huzoor aba prayed

A-74: At the end of Friday Sermon Huzoor aba counseled those present to bring a spiritual revolution in themselves. He also prayed that may you all be enable to observe congregational salat regularly.

Q-75: When did Huzoor aba delivered his second Friday Sermon in Australia

A-75: Huzoor delivered his second Friday sermon in Australia on 21st of April 2006

Q-76: What did Huzoor aba observed in regards to relationship between Ahmadis from Pakistan and Ahmadis from Fiji

A-76: Huzoor aba said that while the Australian Jama'at is second to none in sincerity and loyalty he had sensed some differences between the traditionalist and senior Ahmadis who has immigrated from Pakistan and the Ahmadis of other ethnic backgrounds like Fijian Ahmadis

Q-77: What did Huzoor asked the youth of Australia in his Friday sermon of 21st April 2006

A-77: Addressing the youth Huzoor aba said that they have made the Baia'at of the Promised Messiah and not of anyone else, so they ought to keep the Promised Messiah's model in view

Q-78: Huzoor aba read an extract from Promise Messiah's book in his Friday sermon delivered on 21st April 2006 in regards to Taqwa (piety). What did he said

A-78: Huzoor aba said that we had seen the time of Messiah and we needed to therefore, strengthen our faith and please our God, cleanse our self from malice, spite and hatred and exhibit moral miracles to the world

Q-79: What did Huzoor aba said regarding the glad tiding in his Friday sermon of 21st April 2006

A-79: Reading an extract from Promised Messiah as Huzoor aba said that we were fortunate in that we have experienced that time of which each prophet of God had given glad tiding

Q-80: Observing the manifestation of Allah's grace on the community of Messiah what did Huzoor aba explained

A-80: Observing the manifestation of Allah's grace on the community of Messiah is, Huzoor aba said that it is synonymous to seeing the Promised Messiah

Q-81: What did Huzoor aba said in regards to self reflection in his Friday sermon of 21st April 2006

A-81: Huzoor aba said we needed to self reflect and analyze ourselves rather than be prying and judgmental about others. Self-reflection is what will please our Lord, it is hat will dispel malice and it is what will establish moral miracles.

Q-82: What did Huzoor aba advised in relation to sympathy to others in his Sermon of 21st April 2006

A-82: Huzoor aba emphasized the importance of sympathy and love for one's own kind. Huzoor aba said unless we demonstrate excellent models of courtesy and stopped mutual ill will and resentment we could not be deserving to partake of this description

Q-83: What did Huzoor aba explained about forgiveness in his Friday sermon of 21st April 2006

A-83: Huzoor aba said that if a mistake is made it should be overlooked but if things exceed limits then the relevant people should be informed and then one must be silent about it. No one should feel that so and so or an office holder have malice towards them

Q-84: Give the dates when Huzoor aba delivered the Friday sermons in Australia

A-84: Huzoor delivered his First Friday sermon in Australia on April 14th 2006 and second Friday Sermon on 21st April 2006

Q-85: Who bought Ahmadiyyat or who is the first Ahmadi of Australia

A-85: Hazrath Soofi Hassan Moosa Khan sahib is the first Ahmadi of Australia and he joined Ahmadiyyat in 1903

Q-86: What did Huzoor aba stressed the need in his Friday Sermon on 14th April 2006

A-86: Huzoor aba stressed the need to adorn ones salat

Q-87: What are the things did Huzoor aba said as a pre-requisite to Salat

A-87: Huzoor aba stressed the need to observe Wadhoo and timing of salat

Q-88: Promised Messiah as wrote a letter to Hazrath Soofi Hassan Moosa Khan sahib in 1903. What did Promised Messiah as advised to Khan Sahib

A-88: Promise Messiah as in is letter to Khan Sahib advised him to be punctual in salat, recite Istigfar continuously and abide by Taqwa

Q-89: There was a drought during Huzoor aba's visit to Australia in NSW. What did Huzoor aba advised Ahmadis to overcome this problem

A-89: Huzoor aba said that Ahmadis could be a source of eliminating the problems of humanity with enhanced worship, in particular to benefit other with the water of spirituality

Q-90: Huzoor aba mentioned the attributes of Istigfar in his Friday Sermon. What did he mentioned

A-90: Huzoor aba mentioned that Allah may cover a person's natural weaknesses, it also denotes that one's past sins are covered by God. However the real essence of Istigfar is that Allah's power protects one from one's natural failings and frailties and grants light from his light

Q-91: Huzoor aba put some light on Taqwa in his Sermon of 14th April 2006. what did he said

A-91: Huzoor aba remarked that there were many among those present who had immigrated to Australia. While there financial and social standard has improved, they also need to improve the standard of their Taqwa rather than be influenced by the dazzle of this world

Q-92: What did Huzoor aba mentioned about Khilafat and Wasiyyat in his Sermon of 14th April 2006

A-92: Huzoor aba explained that Promised Messiah as has left us with the institution of Khilafat and Wasiyyat through which we may discipline ourselves and service the humanity

Q-93: Which Surahs have only one alphabet for their name

A:-93: Surah Qaf, Surah Noon, Surah Suad

Q-94: How many Surah's of the Holy Quran are Makki and How many are Madni

A-94: There are 86 Surahs which are Makki and 28 Surahs are Madni

Q-95: What is the best edible that is mentioned in the Holy Quran

A-95: Honey

Q-96: In which Surah is the Emigration of Prophet (pbuh) mentioned

A-96: In Surah HIJR

Q-97: What was the age of Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) when he passed away and how many years did he lived after claiming Nabuvvat

A-97: Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) was 63 years old when he passed away and he claimed Nabuvvat at the age of 40 and lived 23 years after claiming Nabuvvat

Q-98: Who is the author of the Book “ Women In Islam”

A-98: Hazrath Chowdhury Muhammad Zafrullah Khan Saheb

Q-99: Who is the author of the Book “ The True Islamic Concept of Jihad”

A-99: The Book “The True Islamic Concept of Jihad” is the Friday Sermon delivered by Hazrath Mirza Tahir Ahmad, ra Khalifa IV on 15th February 1985

Q-100: What is the Urdu name of the book “The True Islamic Concept of Jihad” and who translated it in English

A-100: The Urdu name is Islam ka Nazriyah-e-Jihad aur Jama'at Ahmadiyya and this is translated in English by Pir Wahid Ahmad Sahib
